But racist laws forced them out. So no Chinese names are on this list. Matching names with their nation of origin is not easy or always correct. It's even more difficult if you don't hear the names spoken. What names do you suspect are from which countries? Why?

FUN FACT

Sonoma Plaza is built on Coast Miwok land. "Miwok" means "the people," and they lived here for around 10,000 years before Mission Solano and Mexican soldiers destroyed their way of life and environment. That was some 200 years ago.
